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Mastering the Present Perfect Tense - Road to Grammar

Constructing negative sentences and questions in the present perfect tense. It is easy to form questions in the present perfect tense. We use HAVE/HAS followed by the subject and the past participle: Have you seen Jack lately? Has Jack finished reading his book? To form a WH question, just add the WH word on to the beginning of the sentence:
